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Cut two on fold






For a narrower version(knits only) use the narrow sleeve line only on stretchy knits.

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



Pattern printing, assembly tips and copyright info:

- 1. Download pattern to your pc.
- 2. Open with Adobe Acrobat Reader (not the reader in Google Docs.)
- 3. Turn off all formatting, chose actual size and auto portrait/landscape.
- 4. Cut out each block around the outer gray edge and allign the gray boxes, edge to edge (don't overlap) matching up colored circles.
- 5. Tape pattern together and cut out size needed.
- 6. For best, long sleeve length can be cut to individual size.
- 7. Pattern instructions and tutorial can be found at:

8. Pattern includes a 1/4 inch seam allowance and a 1/2 inch bottom hem allowance.


